What is Anand Gurukul all about?

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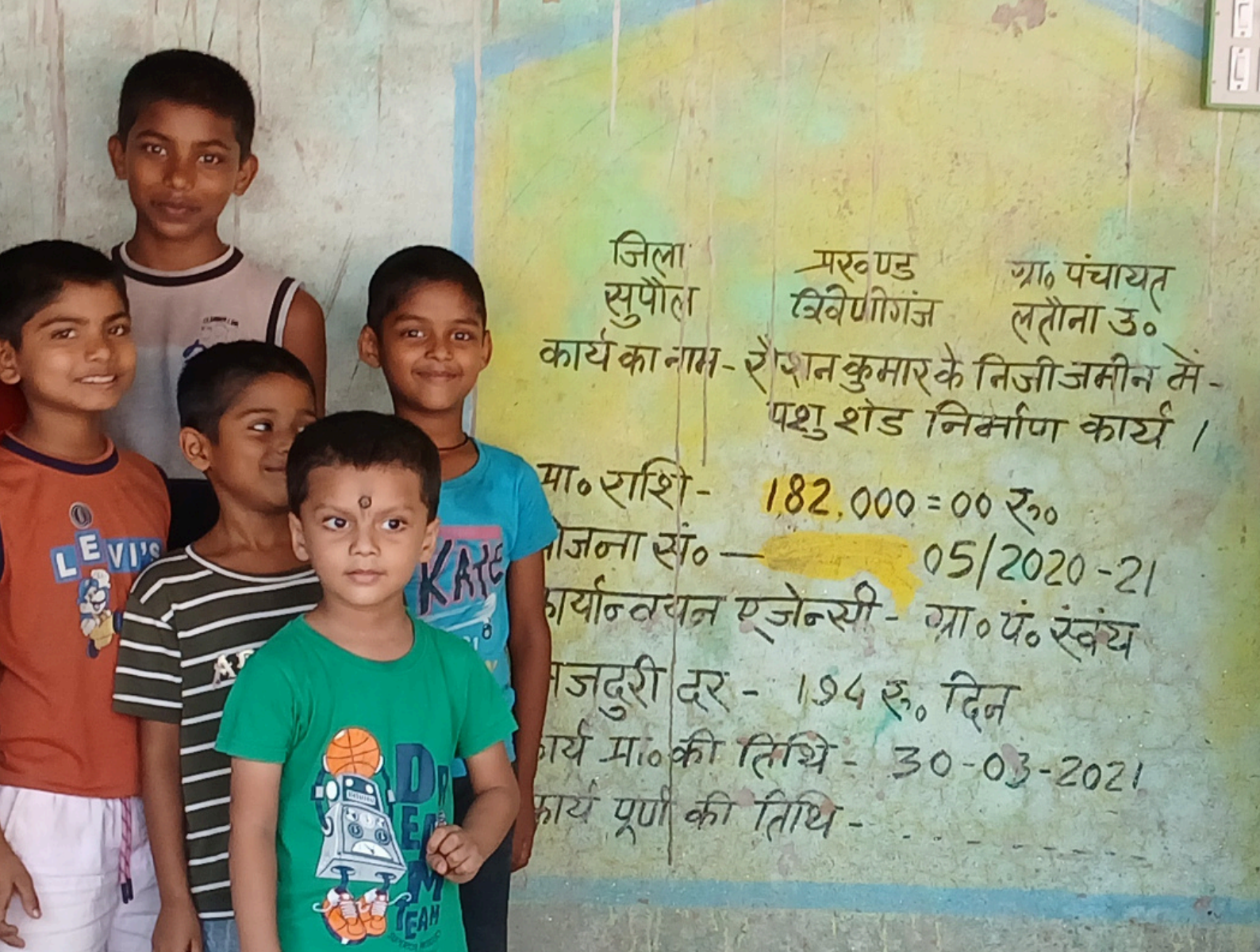

Today, those makeshift beginnings have evolved into a significant milestone: a pashu shed converted into a welcoming and functional hall of residence for our children.

Over 25 students now live and learn in an environment that has visibly transformed them. They wake up to structured routines, take part in morning assemblies, attend subject-based classes, play organised sports, and receive moral and life-skill lessons. Discipline, self-confidence, and curiosity have flourished.

This journey has been made possible entirely through the personal contributions and unwavering dedication of the founding trustees. With no external funding to date, our progress stands as living proof of what vision, commitment, and collective will can achieve — and as a strong foundation for the bigger dream that lies ahead.



Why Anand Gurukul Matters Now

The children of Anand Gurukul now enjoy what many in regular schools do — the rhythm of a regular school life. The need to wear uniforms with pride, follow timetables, complete homework, and undergo assessments is now a part of the immediate transition.

They participate in activities that stimulate both intellect and character, creating habits that will serve them for life. But while the transformation so far is inspiring, it is also fragile. Our current facilities, though a vast improvement from the tents, remain temporary.

To sustain and grow this progress, we urgently need a permanent, purpose-built residential campus — one with adequate classrooms, dormitories, science and computer labs, sports facilities, and spaces for art and culture.

Our vision is to make Anand Gurukul a truly autonomous and self-governing institution — not owned by any one individual, but stewarded by a board and supported by the community, ensuring that it thrives for decades and impacts countless future generations.

The next chapter for Anand Gurukul is both ambitious and achievable. We aim to create a fully residential boarding school that blends academic excellence with life-skills training, sports, and moral development.

This will require significant infrastructure — modern classrooms, well-equipped laboratories, a library, sports grounds, safe dormitories, hygienic dining facilities, and sustainable utilities such as clean water and solar power.

Until now, every step forward — from tents to the hall of residence — has been entirely self-funded by the founding trustees. This has demonstrated our commitment, but we know that building the future we envision will require the strength of many hands. Phase 1: Pilot	100	Years 1–2	Build initial dorm & classrooms; hire small team; establish culture; proof of concept.	4–5
Phase 2: Early Growth	500	Years 3–4	Expand dorms & classrooms; add library, kitchen, basic sports; regional fundraising.	25–30
Phase 3: Institutional Stability	1,000	Years 5–6	Add labs, auditorium, better housing & admin; strengthen operations; national awareness.	60–70
Phase 4: Regional Model	5,000	Years 7–9	Full campus zone with boys & girls blocks, healthcare, recreation, robust systems.	350–400
Phase 5: National Impact	20,000	Years 10–12	Build campus city with advanced facilities, vocational & competitive prep, endowment fund.	1,250–1,500
Phase 6: Flagship Campus	50,000	Years 13–15	Final flagship campus with university-level support, green campus, global partnerships.	3,000–3,500

- Costs include infrastructure + furniture + 2–3 years of operating costs per phase.
 - Costs are approximate and meant for strategic planning, and will be validated by detailed current feasibility studies.
 - Timeline assumes smooth funding and approvals — will be adjusted accordingly.

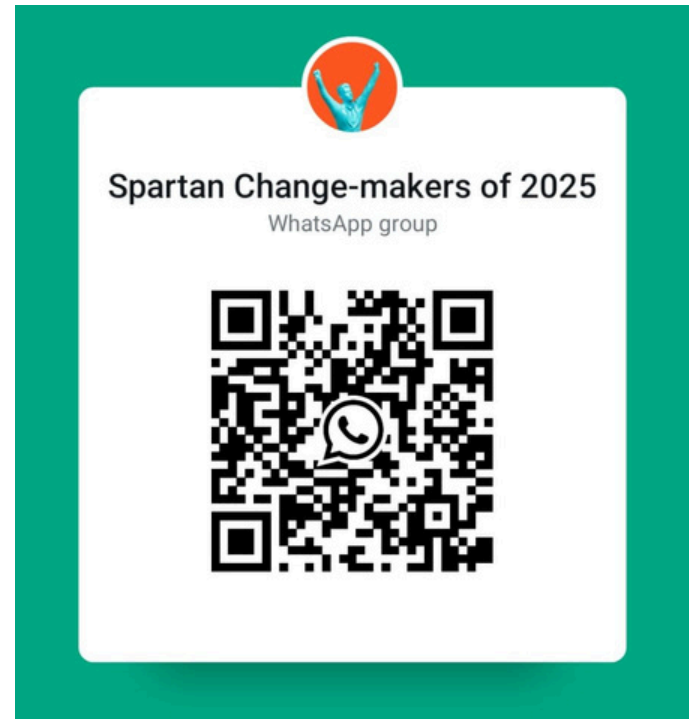
