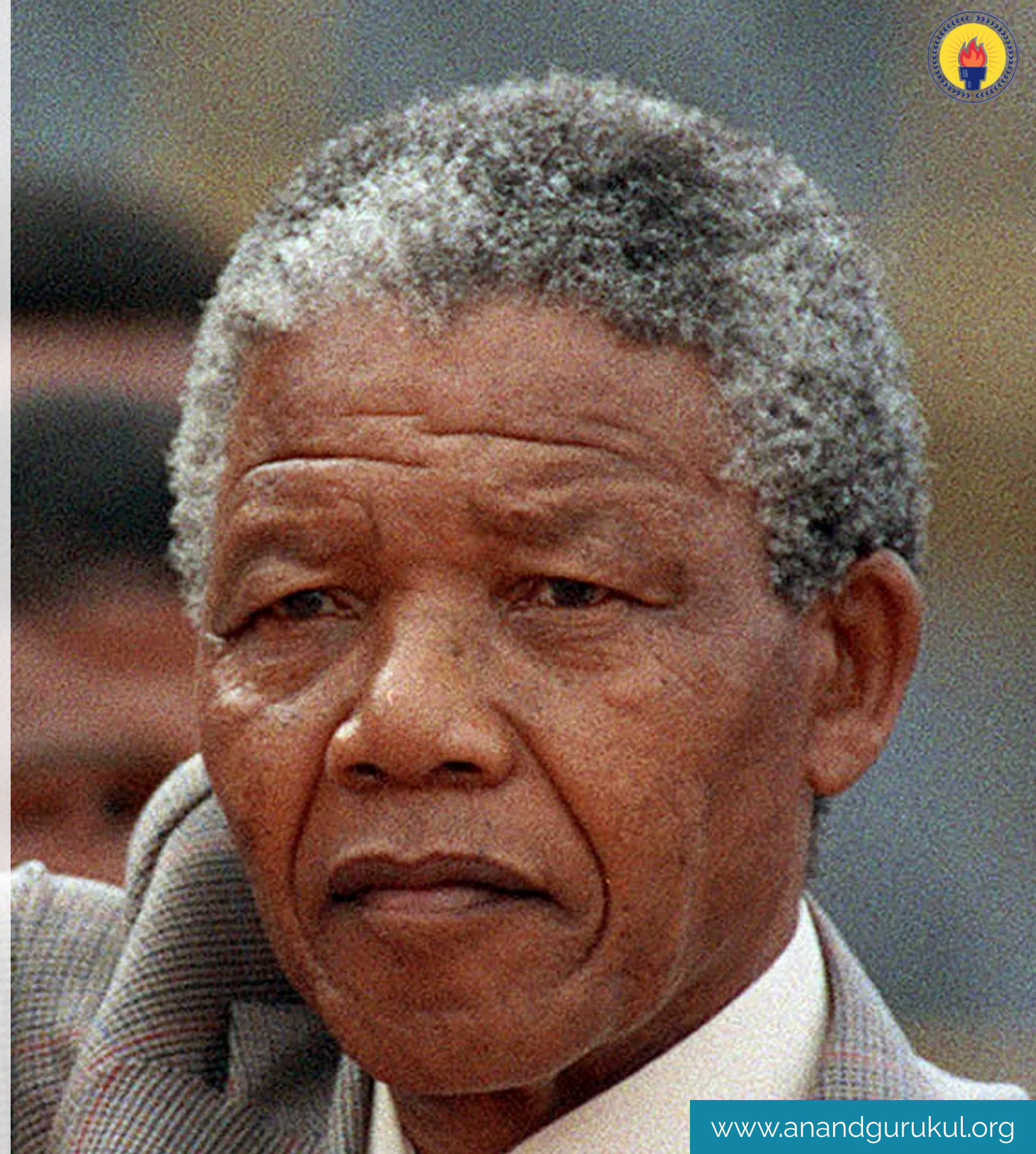


# Nothing is Impossible

- **Who:** Community-led, teacher-driven, student-centered.

# How Will We Do It

- Build physical infrastructure.
- Recruit & train local educators.
- Blend traditional knowledge with modern learning.
- Community participation in governance.

“One drop may not fill a bucket, but without that drop, the bucket will never be full.”



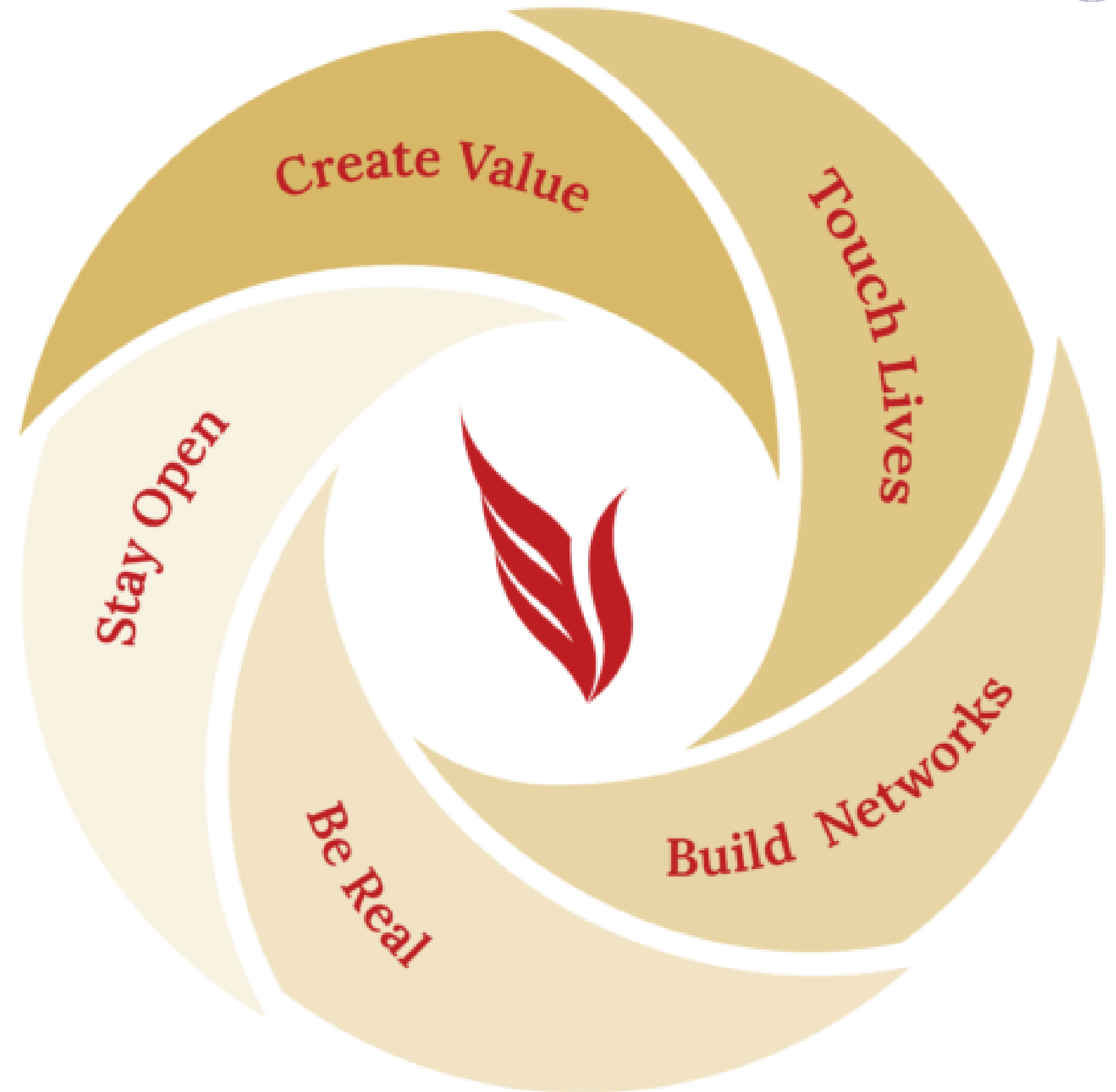




# Go-Givers Get More

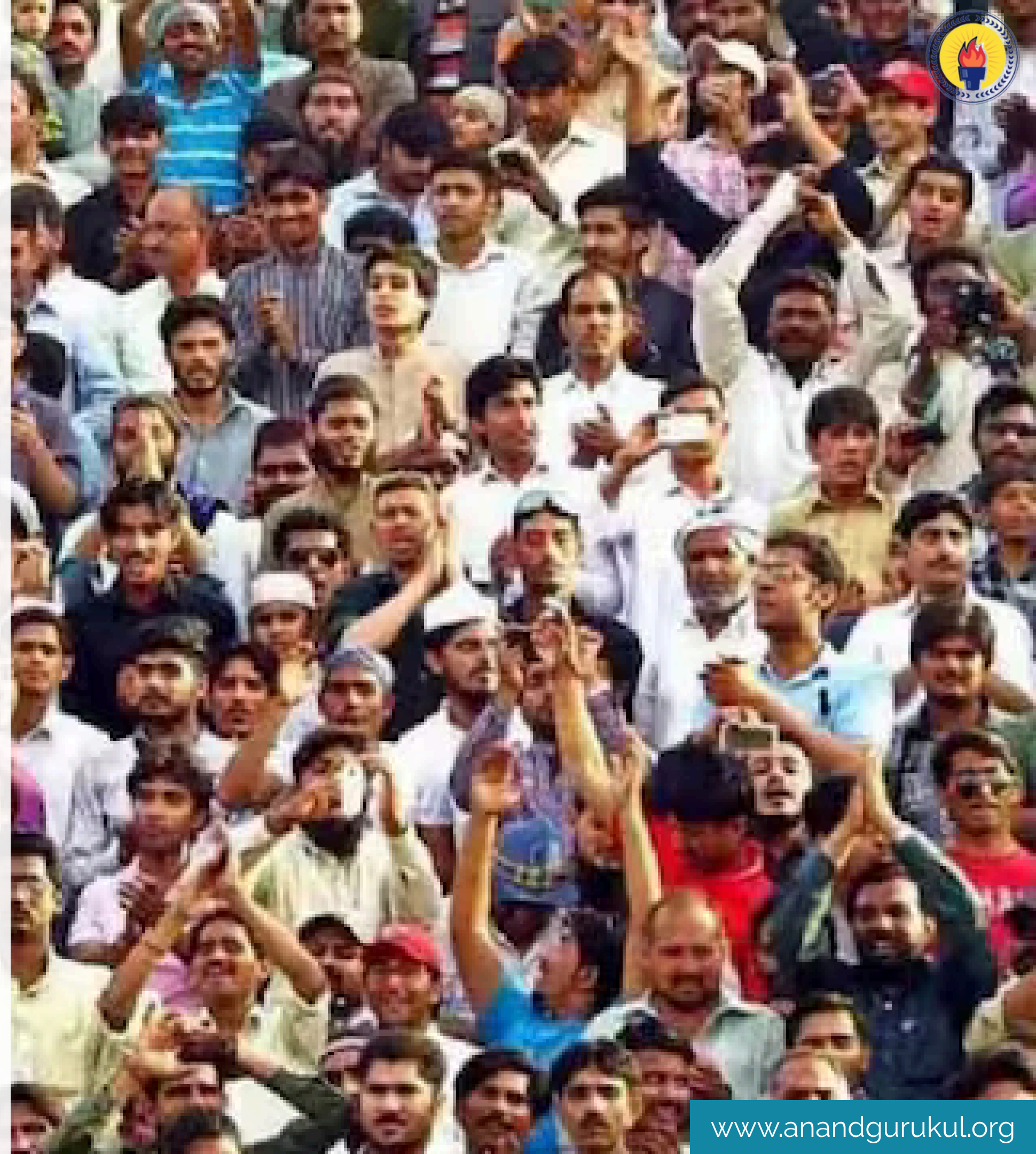




# Why Bihar? Why Now?

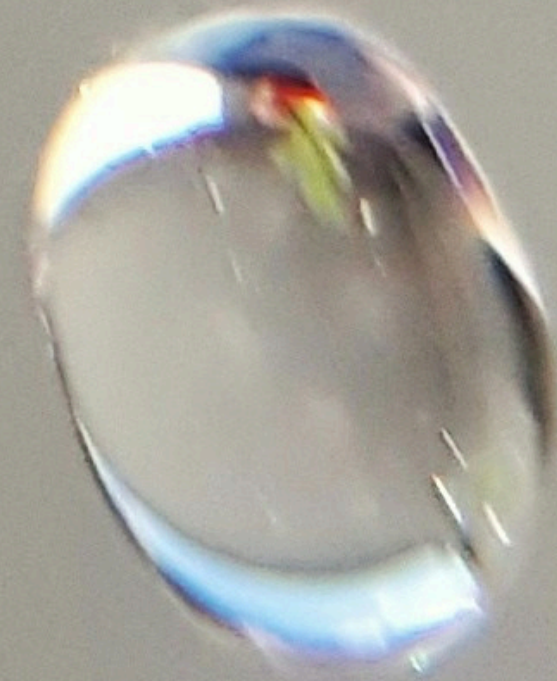
